

Roadway Crashes in Cameroon

April 2024 Fact Sheet

In line with RIC’s mission to provide information related to roadway and traffic conditions in Cameroon, RIC presents the **April 2024 Fact Sheet** for roadway-related crashes in the country of Cameroon.

Please note these numbers are based on reported crashes by news outlets. See RIC’s website for sources utilized for this monthly fact sheet.

During the month of April 2024, a total of 10 crashes were reported and at least 5 deaths resulted from these crashes. A monthly breakdown can be seen in Tables 1 and 2. In the year 2023 for the same months, a total of 9 crashes were reported resulting in at least 11 deaths. Provided below in Figures 3 and 4 are side-by-side view of the crash and death count for the years of 2023 to 2024.

Figure 1 Monthly Crash Count (2024)

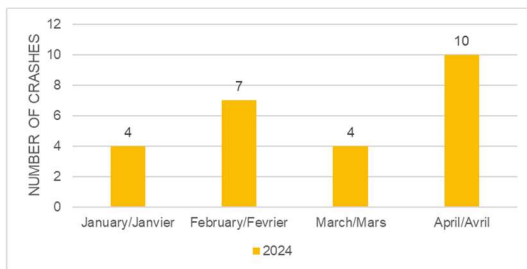


Figure 2 Monthly Death Count due to Crashes (2024)

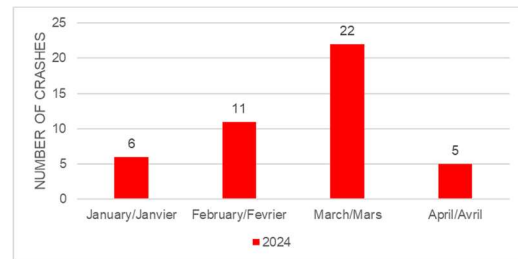


Figure 3 Monthly Crash Count (2023 V 2024)

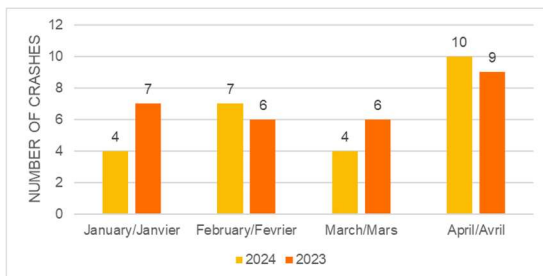
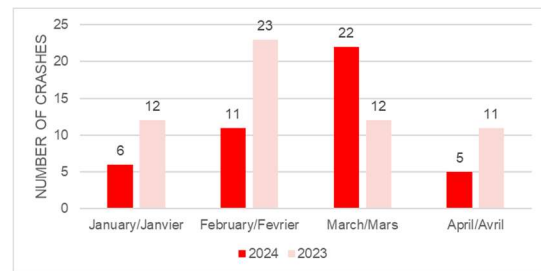


Figure 4 Monthly Death Count (2023 V 2024)
