Table 1 Number of Roadway Accidents per Month

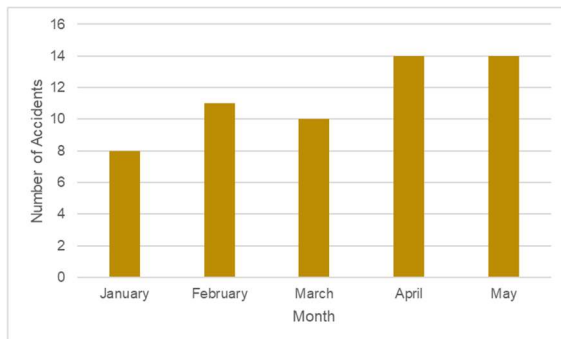
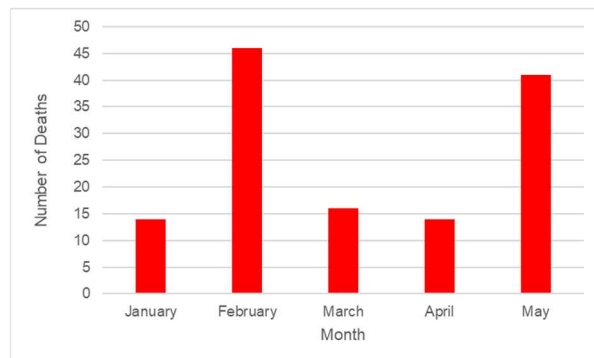


Table 2 Number of Roadway Deaths per Month



The accident which recorded the most death count In May of 2023 was in Eseka in the Littoral Region, where at least 15 people died after their bus collided with a truck.
